



BOSNIA SYMPOSIUM

The large number of Muslims living in the West is a unique feature of our modern times. It raises possibilities in an exciting and dynamic context. But despite the size, diversity and dynamism this group of people are finding themselves pushed from pillar to post. There has been little time to introspect and reflect on the conditions they find themselves in. It is a messy situation. In an instant we have been thrown together from over 100 nationalities and languages, representing diverse madhabs, cultures, histories and identities and most, for the first time finding themselves in a totally unfamiliar context. The line between Dar al Islam and Dar al Harb is no longer in existence: in the globalized village the very relevance of Islam and its pertinence is up for grabs.

The Sarajevo Symposium will bring together scholars, community leaders, charity workers, activists and lay people to engage with issues of shared concern. From the heart of Europe, in Sarajevo it will bring together the maturity of traditional wisdom with the unfamiliarity of our present. Complementing the Symposium will be an organized tour of the sights, sounds and heritage of Bosnia.

As part of the programme there will be a series of meetings with local religious and community leaders from different faiths and opinion makers.

AL-HABIB UMAR BIN HAFIZ

He is the erudite scholar, the caller to Allah, al-ḤabībʿUmar bin Muḥammad bin Sālim bin Ḥafīz ibn ShaykhAbū Bakr bin Sālim al-Alawī al-Ḥasanī, from the lineage of the Seal of the Prophets, the Prophet Muḥammad. He was born in Tarim, Hadramaut, in the Republic of Yemen .

Ḥabīb ʿUmar received all his early education in the city of his birth, Tarim, at the hands of his father, al-Ḥabīb Muḥammad bin Sālim, the mufti of Tarim, and other revered scholars. He memorised the Magnificent Quran at an early age and was reared in a pious fashion, in the care of his father, in an environment of knowledge, faith and virtuous character. In 1981, the situation became untenable for him to stay in South Yemen due to the communist regime and so Habib Umar migrated to the city of al-Bayda in North Yemen where he continued his studies.

He then moved from al-Shihr toTarim, where he settled and founded Dar al-Mustafa, a centre for traditional Islamic scholarship that currently hosts an array of international students, in Tarim, Yemen. It is based on three objectives: the first being learning the sciences of the Sacred Law and related sciences from those who are apt to impart them with connected chains of transmission; the second purifying the soul and refining one's character and the third conveying beneficial knowledge and calling to God. Many of the graduates have gone on to become leading figures worldwide.



He has authored several books, such as al-Dhakirah al-Musharrafah, which is a summary of obligatory knowledge for every Muslim, three short hadith compilations and a summary of the third quarter of Imam al-Ghazali's Ihya' `Ulum al-Din. His mawlid compositions, al-Diya' al-Lami'and al-Sharab al-Tahurare, are recited in gatherings throughout the world.


